Subject annotation

The subject of international and European Union intellectual property law is intended to analyze and evaluate the legal protection of copyright, related rights, individual industrial property objects - patents, trademarks, industrial designs, trade names, topographies of semiconductor products, geographical and geographical indications, know-how.

Topics analyzed: the content of copyright and related rights, restrictions, participation in civil circulation, implementation and protection problems; registration of industrial property objects, legal protection is granted to the content of rights, their protection, mutual relations; international treaties on fundamental intellectual property rights (Paris Convention 1883, Berne Convention 1886, Rome Convention 1961, World Intellectual Property Organization Treaties 1996, TRIPS Agreement, Patent Cooperation Treaty 1970, European Patents Convention 1973) Systems established and operating in the European Union for the legal protection of individual intellectual property objects: the system of patent protection, the system of protection of the Community trademark, the system of design protection, etc.

Upon completion of the course, the doctoral student must have mastered the system of categories of international and EU intellectual property law and have knowledge of how the same categories are perceived and interpreted in the doctrine of law, legislative process and jurisprudence. After completing the study, the doctoral student must be able to analyze the chosen problem of intellectual property law in the broader context of theoretical problems of law, be able to apply various methods of legal research to assess and solve theoretical and practical problems of intellectual property law.
